Day 1

Location: Luang Prabang

Activity: Visit Luang Prabang

Culture, Tradition & Dawn in Luang Prabang!

Begin the day at sunrise with the serene tradition of alms giving, observing saffron-robed monks move silently through the streets of Luang Prabang. Wander through the bustling morning market, where locals gather to trade fresh produce and street food. After breakfast, explore the city's rich cultural heritage by visiting beautifully preserved temples and museums, which offer insight into Laos' spiritual traditions, colonial history, and daily life.



Day 2

Jungle Trails & Turquoise Pools!

A full day immersed in nature as we trek through forest trails to the spectacular Kuang Si Waterfall. Swim in crystal-clear turquoise pools, relax beside cascading falls, and enjoy a slower pace surrounded by jungle and limestone cliffs.

Rice, Roots & Rural Life!

Step into the rhythm of rural Laos at Living Land Farm. Learn the entire traditional rice-growing process — from ploughing with water buffalo to planting and harvesting — gaining hands-on insight into the crop that underpins Lao culture and daily life.



Day 4

Location: Luang Prabang to Vang Vieng

Activity: On afternoon, travel from Luang Prabang to Vang Vieng

Journey to the Karst Wonderland!

Travel south through dramatic countryside to Vang Vieng, watching the landscape shift into towering limestone karsts and river valleys. Evening free to settle in, explore, or unwind after the journey.

A gentler day to recharge. Explore a hidden river cave by tube, then cool off at the iconic Blue Lagoon. Swimming, relaxing, and optional activities — this is classic Vang Vieng at its most chilled.
